COURSE OVERVIEW	Display Screen Equipment (DSE) Short Course is designed to ensure that users of DSE set up their workstations effectively and ergonomically, avoiding the health risks associated with their use. Learners undertaking this course will learn what DSE is, the health risks associated with its use, how to use DSE appropriately and the importance of correct posture and regular breaks. Finally, the course will outline the kind of support employers should provide for users of DSE at work.
